RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the District Manager review and file the Operations Department Project Status Report for the week ending October 28, 2005.

BACKGROUND:

Blackstone Booster Replacement/Upgrade

Staff continued with construction of the Blackstone Booster Pumping Station Replacement Project. During the reporting period, staff poured the concrete foundation and procured materials for the block building. The budget project consists of a complete upgrade including duplex pumps, new electrical, SCADA control, emergency operations and security.

Foreman Creek Turbidity Monitoring

During the reporting period, staff installed a 24-hour all weather turbidity monitoring station in Foreman Creek. The station will record turbidity in the creek during high storm flow periods.

Bacteriological Sampling Station

During the reporting period, staff continued with the installation of Bacteriological Sampling Stations. The Quail Hollow Road station was completed. These stations are dedicated to bacteriological water quality monitoring throughout the distribution system.

Property Cleanup/Winter Preparation

During the reporting period, staff did light grading and placed drain rock on District property located on Highway 9. Drainage was improved and drain rock was placed on the driveway for all winter access.
