RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors review and file the Engineering Department status report for the week ending December 9, 2005.

BACKGROUND:

Watershed Mapping

Engineering has prepared a map of the watershed area located on Ben Lomond mountain near the five mile pipeline. Engineering is also preparing additional maps for use by the District's hydrogeologist to evaluate the efficiency of the District's use of the watershed.

100 Scale Update

Engineering is updating the 100 scale map showing the new main connecting the Pasotiempo wells.

Urban Water Management Plan

Engineering continues writing the document.

Zayante School Road Easements

Big Trees Railroad has reviewed and tentatively accepted the offer for the SLVWD to purchase a ten foot wide easement. Engineering field reviewed the site with the surveyor and the Operations Department to make adjustments to the project. Engineering has requested a copy of the deed from Big Trees Railroad. Engineering will complete a draft of the easement and draft an agreement for approval by all parties.

Manana Woods Service Area Map

Engineering is preparing the survey description for a map that will be used in the LAFCO annexation of Manana Woods. Engineering has located existing improvements along Whispering Pines Drive and Lundy Lane. Engineering has drawn an initial route to interconnect the SLVWD system to the Manana Woods system.

Bear Creek Wastewater As-Builts

Engineering is completing the as-builts of the upgraded wastewater treatment plant at Bear Creek Estates.

Administration Building and Bear Creek Underground Tank Removal

No Activity during this time period.

Tipping Way

Engineering and Operations met with the property owners to discuss alternative easements for the proposed project. The property owners are field staking the proposed easement to verify if there is enough room to install a water line using a backhoe.
