Regional Water Systems Emergency Interties No. 2, 3, & 4 Project

The San Lorenzo Valley Water District, Scotts Valley Water District, and Mount Hermon Association have partnered to develop a capital improvement project that will allow the Districts to share water resources in emergencies such as fires and natural disasters. The project is known as the San Lorenzo Valley Water District Regional Water Systems Emergency Interties No. 2, 3, & 4 Project (Project). The \$5.7 million project is partially funded by a California State Grant issued under Proposition 50, otherwise known as the Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002.

The Project includes the installation of approximately 17,600 lineal feet of potable water piping along several roads and streets in the vicinity of Scotts Valley and Felton including Skypark Drive, Lockewood Lane, Graham Hill Road, Summit Avenue, Roaring Camp Road, East Zayante Road, West Zayante Road, and Conference Drive. In addition, the Project includes the construction of two booster pump stations one of which will be located at the Skypark Drive entrance to the City of Scotts Valley's Linear Park and the other of which will be located along Summit Avenue close to where Summit Avenue intersects Graham Hill Road.

Construction of the pipeline will begin February 1, 2015 along County and City roadways and will be performed between 8:30 am and 4:00 pm Monday through Friday, excluding holidays for a period of 1 year. Temporary traffic controls will be used in the vicinity of active construction along the roadways which will result in temporary traffic delays. Signs will be posted and fliers will be distributed to residences near active roadway construction areas in advance of the work. Construction of the booster pump stations will be performed between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.
