SLV Water District seeks public input on 5-year plan

The San Lorenzo Valley Water District will hold two public meetings on Tuesday, July 26 and invites the community to participate as the District creates its strategic plan for the next five years. An afternoon meeting is scheduled from 2-3:30 p.m. at the Felton Community Hall, 6191 Highway 9, in downtown Felton. An evening meeting is scheduled from 7:30-9 p.m. at Highlands Park Senior Center, 8500 Highway 9, Ben Lomond.

"A strategic plan is a roadmap that serves to focus our energies and invest our resources into the future," said District Manager James Mueller. "The purpose of these meetings is to actively solicit ideas from our community to create a realistic roadmap for the District over the next five years," he said.
