OFFSITE TRANSPORTATION AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENT FEE CREDITS FOR APTOS, LIVE OAK, PAJARO VALLEY AND SOQUEL

This schedule allows a credit against the transportation and roadside improvement fees, up to the full amount of fees, whenever a developer is required to construct offsite transportation or roadside improvements which are included in the inventory of capital improvements.

Valuation of transportation and roadside improvements shall be established by the approving body at the time of iscretionary permit approval based upon this schedule.

Preliminary engineered improvement plans are required for determining the type and quantity of roadside and roadway improvements eligible for construction cost credit.

Credits detailed below are at maximum allowed and are dependent on developer's documentation of cost.

TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT FEE CREDIT

Valuation of transportation improvements shall be established based upon a preliminary engineered improvement plan including a cost estimate prepared by a registered engineer.

The construction cost estimate shall provide full compensation for furnishing all construction labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in finishing the entire project.

Full compensation for any necessary finishing shall be considered as included in the cost of the estimate and no additional compensation will be allowed.
