RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the District Manager review and file the Operations Department Project Status Report for the week ending June 01, 2007.

BACKGROUND:

Meter Change Over Program

During the reporting period staff spent the majority of time performing water meter change-outs in the North Boulder Creek. The meter change out program is behind schedule and it is intended to be on schedule by end of this fiscal year. Meters are changed out every fifteen years to ensure accuracy as water meter accuracy decreases with age.

Water Sampling Stations

As part of the District's water quality sampling program water sampling stations are being installed District wide. During the reporting period staff install four stations in the Ben Lomond area. It is anticipated that by the end of June all purchased stations will be installed and will be in use.

Vehicle Auction

During the reporting period the two surplus vehicles were sold at auction. Truck 149 sold for \$1,800. and Truck 312 sold for \$1,700. The auction was conducted over the Memorial Day weekend.

Olympia Well 2 Failure

On May 25, 2007 Olympia Well 2 failed. A motor overload condition was diagnosed requiring the well to be removed from service and the pump and motor pulled for inspection. It was determined that the pump bearing failed creating a motor overload condition. The pump and motor was replaced and return to the manufacture as the equipment is under manufacture warranty. This work was completed over the Memorial Day weekend as this well is consider one of the District's large production wells.
