PROTEST BALLOT

This Protest Ballot is provided for the convenience of property owners and water account holders of the San Lorenzo Valley Water District (District). It may be used to file a protest against the increased water rates and charges proposed by the District. Regardless of how many protests are submitted for a property, only one valid protest will be counted for each parcel receiving water service from the District.

To be counted, a valid protest must be **received** by the District no later than the close of the public comment portion of the Public Hearing to be conducted on Thursday, February 15, 2024 beginning at 6:30 p.m. Protest Ballots can be submitted as follows:

- By mail addressed to San Lorenzo Valley Water District, Water Rate Protest, 13060 Highway 9, Boulder Creek, CA 95006
- 2. By depositing it in a District drop box, at one of the following drop box locations:
 - a. Main Office, 13060 Highway 9, Boulder Creek, CA (last pickup at 3:00 p.m.)
 - b. Felton Treatment Plant, 195 Kirby Street, Felton, CA (last pickup at 6:00 a.m.).
- 3. By email to Prop218@slvwd.com.
- 4. In person at the February 15, 2024 meeting located at the San Lorenzo Valley Water District Conference Room, 12788 Hwy 9, Boulder Creek, CA 95006. Note ballots must be completed and signed. All ballots must be received by the District Secretary prior to the close of the public comment portion of the Public Hearing on the Water Rates.

Note: Fold and insert the ballot in an envelope and seal the envelope before mailing, placing in a drop box, or delivering in person.

If according to the final tabulation of the ballots, ballots submitted against the rate increase are received from a simple majority of 50 percent of the total accounts plus one, the District shall not adjust the water rates. **Any Protest Ballot received late by the District will not be counted, regardless of when it was sent.**

To be valid, this Protest Ballot must clearly show all of the requested information, as follows:
