a. Investment Portfolio Review and Update

Manager Mueller reported that Jim Bargetto, Investment Consultant from Morgan Stanley was present to review and update the Board on the District's Investment Portfolio.

Mr. Bargetto gave the Board a presentation and an overview of the District's Investment Portfolio. Mr. Bargetto stated that the average rate in the current portfolio is 3.55% on all earnings as opposed to 2.85% with LAIF. Mr. Bargetto stated that the portfolio looks outstanding and reported that having a strategy in place rather than predicting rates is the best case scenario. The worst thing the Board could do is try and predict rates.

b. Notice of Acceptance, Underground Fuel Storage Tank Removal Project

Manager Mueller reported that on May 16, 2005, the Board of Directors entered into an agreement with One Earth Environmental, Inc., Hollister, California, for the excavation and disposal of material and complete removal and disposal of an existing aboveground fuel dispenser and three (3) underground fuel storage tanks. Construction commenced on June 13, 2005 and was substantially complete on July 8, 2005.
